

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Leslie J. Stewart has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Rickard) through drilled well, pump and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 41N., R. 40E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 31, bears S. 70° 18' W., a distance of 3,600.1 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Wm. Stock Farming Co.
Post-office address: Paradise Valley, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0312 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 18, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from an 8 inch drilled well, pumped by gasoline engine into 3 concrete troughs 16 feet by 7 feet by 2 feet each, located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 1,000 head of cattle. The place of use is described as being the W 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 31, T. 41N., R. 40E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of this permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
