CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mark Chilton has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 3, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 3, bears S. 44° 50' E., 1830.0 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

37.8 acres in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 3, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M.
156.8 acres total

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 18626 therefore is subject to the terms of the permit under 18626 and retains the same priority as Permit 18626.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
