

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edith E. O'Keefe has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

 through developed spring area and flood irrigation for

 purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW¹ SW¹ Sec. 6, T. 10N., R. 6E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 6 bears S. 36° 10' 47" W., 2049.70 feet.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
 3.280 acres in the NE¹ SE¹ Section 1, T. 10N., R. 6E., M.D.B.&M.

The total duty of water for the lands under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per year from all sources.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
