CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William W. Bliss has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Lake Tahoe through pipeline, pump & distribution system for domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 2, Sec. 10, T. 14N., R. 18E., M.D.B.&M. (extended) or at a point from which the meander corner between section 3 and 10, T. 14N., R. 18E., bears N. 18° 39' W. a distance of 2,750 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The Glenbrook Company
Post-office address: Glenbrook, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.015 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.88 mg. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 16, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner & place of use: water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of an intake pipe and pump and is conveyed by a distribution system to 8 residences & facilities at tennis courts where it is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
