CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground (Dahlstrom Well) source through dug well, pump and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 3S., R. 42E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 2 bears N. 22° 48' 24" W., a distance of 4,496.92 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the site, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Town of Goldfield
Post-office address: Goldfield, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.30 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 3, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a hand dug well, thence pumped into the 6 inch town mains by a 3 hp motor where it is conveyed to the place of use located within the W 1/2 and W 1/2 E 1/2 of Section 2, T. 3S., R. 42E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used for municipal and domestic purposes.

\*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
