CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS James W. Whittey has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Hornet Spring

through Spring, pipe and trough for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 25N., R. 20E., M.D.B.&M. OR at a point from which the Monument -M 102 on PLIR boundary line T. 25N., R. 20E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 78° 50' E., a distance of 4,362.0 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Lettie V. Whittey

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0016 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 5, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use.

Water is collected from the spring area by a 1 inch pipeline to a 18 inch by 36 inch by 28 foot trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 50 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
