CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George W. Fisher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal (trailer park) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Lot A, Tract 47, T. 16S., R. 56E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Tract 47 bears N. 52° 35' 51" E., a distance of 795.87 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator George W. Fisher

Post-office address Indian Springs, Nevada

** Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s. but not to exceed 4.2 mg annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 28, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is produced from a drilled well, thence pumped through the distribution system to the place of use located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Lot A, Tract 47, T. 16S., R. 56E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used to serve 36 trailers and 80 trees.

**The total use is limited to 4.2 million gallons annually from all sources.

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
