CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 2) through drilled well, pump, sprinkling system, for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 20 bears S. 45° 01' W., a distance of 1880.0 feet, situated in Eureka, County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

40.0 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M.
40.0 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M.
158.0 total acres

*The total duty of water for lands under this certificate shall not exceed 4 ac. ft. per acre annually from all sources.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
