WHEREAS R. S. Leighton, Director Land & Water Rights has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Industrial (cooling steam electric generating plant)

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 20N.,

R. 22E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec.

33, bears S. 40° 39' W., 3,395.0 feet.

situated in Storey County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date,

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Date of priority of appropriation as decreed

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

the water is diverted from the Truckee River by means of a low water dam and a screen well intake thence conveyed thru a chlorination unit and then piped to the condensers of a steam electric generating plant. The water is then discharged to a cooling pond of approximately 30 acres of surface area where it circulates and is cooled from evaporation and is then returned to the Truckee River at a point which is upstream from the intake. The place of use is within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 33, T. 20N., R. 22E., M.D.B. & M. This certificate is further issued subject to the terms of the permit and corrects a typographical error from claim No. 628 to claim No. 641, Truckee River Final Decree, as shown in the terms of the permit.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of water under Claim 641, Truckee River Final Decree in Equity Docket No. A-3 in the District Court of the United States in and for the District of Nevada.

(Point of diversion is changed from Proctor Ditch).

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
