CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank W. Groves has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled artesian well to natural channels and ponds for wildlife propagation & recreation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 16N., R. 19E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 1 bears N. 46° 51' 30" E. a distance of 2761.75 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

The place of use is described as being in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 1, T. 16N., R. 19E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
