CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Graham Sanford, Secretary has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Artesian Well No. 7) through flowing artesian well and troughs for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 13N., R. 20E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 30, T. 13N., R. 20E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 27° 10' 55" W. a distance of 9,195.14 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator H. F. Dangberg Land and Livestock Company.

Post-office address Minden, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.03 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 4,000 head of cattle and 3,500 lambs.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 25, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is produced from a flowing artesian well thence conveyed to 300-gallon metal troughs located within the S 1/2 NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T. 13N., R. 20E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used to water 4,000 head of cattle, 3,500 lambs and domestic use.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
