CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harvey A. Dahl has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through spring and excavated sump for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 21, T. 39N., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 21 bears S. 11° 08' E., a distance of 2,091.0 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 22, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is produced by an unnamed spring thence flows into an excavated sump 50 feet by 100 feet located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 21, T. 39N., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M. and used to water 400 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
