CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Bryce Wilson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through pipeline, pump & distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) Sec. 10, T. 14N., R. 18E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 10 bears S. 50° 52' E., a distance of 659.1 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bryce Wilson
Post-office address Glenbrook, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.20 c.f.s. but not to exceed 212.5 thousand gallons annually.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 27, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use
water is diverted in Lake Tahoe thence conveyed by 250 feet of 2 inch pipe to the pump & pressure tank thence by distribution system to a dwelling and guest house located within same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
