CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert J. Zander has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Jackpot Well) through drilled well, pump and distribution system for domestic (school) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 47N., R. 64E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 12, bears N. 81° 18' W., a distance of 2,134.00 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.055 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 5, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well thence pumped into a pressure system and piped to the place of use located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used for school purposes during the school year and building and yard maintenance during the summer months.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
