

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. V. Caselli (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump & sprinkler system for irrigation & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 22N., R. 54E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 5 bears S. 45° 0' E. a distance of 1817.0 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 3, 1960

160 acres in the NE 1/4 Section 5, T. 22N., R. 54E., M.D.B. & M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 19237 hence the priority of appropriation of this certificate is the same as Permit No. 19237.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
