CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joseph F. Leisek has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dry Creek through pipeline and distribution system for Milling

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 7, T. 1 S., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 83° 48' E., 9580.0 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Don P. Thompson and I. L. Elder
Post-office address: Santa Maria, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.123 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 26, 1959

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is conveyed from Dry Creek by a diversion dam and 2 1/2 miles of 6" pipe to the millsite located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used in the processing of cinnabar bearing ores.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
