CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed Creek (Creek "B") through dam and ditch and reservoir for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 47 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 12 bears N. 3° 54' E., a distance of 2,527.0 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.027 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle and 50 horses
Period of use, from April 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 28, 1964

Description of works of diversion manner and place of use: water is diverted from Creek "B" by a 4 feet by 30 feet dam, thence conveyed 4,000 feet by "V" ditch to a small natural lake located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 47 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M. and the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 47 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to water 800 head of cattle and 50 horses.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
