CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well pump & troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 38 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 3 bears N. 62° 08' W. a distance of 2594.0 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Wells, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.00625 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 12, 1966

Description of water is developed at the well, thence conveyed to two water troughs 4'x 4'x 11' located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion and used to water 200 head of cattle.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
