CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and pressure system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, T. 33 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Sec. 19 bears S. 83° 53' 47" W. a distance of 2,802.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.00223 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,440 gallons per day.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 27, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is produced from a drilled well, pumped into a 30 gallon pressure tank, thence conveyed by 100 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to the place of use located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19, T. 33 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M. where it is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified; and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
