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WHEREAS, R. S. Leighton, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River (Idlewild Treatment Plant) and pumped into a distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Idlewild Pump Station

SE¼ SE¼ Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 10, bears S. 69°57'58" E., a distance of 842.34 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the Truckee River via an intake structure, pumped to the Idlewild Treatment Plant and conveyed via a distribution system to the place of use located within Sections 34, 35 and 36, T.20N., R.19E., Sections 31, 32 and 33, T.20N., R.20E., Sections 4 through 9, 17 through 20 and Section 30, T.19N., R.20E., Sections 1 through 4, 8 through 18, and 20 through 27, T.19N., R.19E., MDB&M, where it is used for municipal and domestic purposes.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Claim 494, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 494.

This certificate is corrected to accurately reflect the rate of diversion and maximum duty of water allowed, and reflects the current owner of record as shown in the office of the State Engineer.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master.
