CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 43N., R. 37E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Sec. 20 bears S. 32° 10' 48" E. a distance of 143.9 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Chapter 46 of Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.04 c.f.s. but not to exceed 12.56 acre feet per season
Period of use, from: March 1st to November 1st of each year
\* Date of priority of appropriation: December 3, 1952

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
3.14 acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 20, T. 43N., R. 37E., M.D.B. & M.
3.14 acres total

\*This Certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 14649, hence the priority of appropriation of this Certificate is the same as Permit 14649. This certificate is issued subject to the terms of Permit 14649.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
