CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS E.D.Ciliax, Manager, Foodland Market has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 35, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 35 bears S. 40° 37' 40" W. a distance of 2,090.6 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Maxwell Kelch, Edgar D. Ciliax and Betty Douglas Wilson, a co-partnership doing business as Vegas Foods Company, each as to an undivided 1/3 interest
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada (one-third) interest

Amount of appropriation: 0.10 c.f.s. but not to exceed 365,000 gallons annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: January 12, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is developed by means of a drilled well and flows through pipelines to the Foodland Market located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sect 35, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used in the produce department and for fire protection.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
