CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joseph D. Tate has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump & distribution system for Irrigation & Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 13 bears S. 78° 36' 40" W., 2,588.7 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joseph D. Tate
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0026 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1,660 gallons per day
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 23, 1953

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to a residence, a lawn and 25 trees located within the E 1/2 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M. D. B. & M. where it is used for irrigation and domestic purposes.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
