CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jeanne Arambel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, storage tank, and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 18N., R. 55E., MDD. B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 8 bears S. 50° 56' 44" W. a distance of 3,444.27 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0163 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2000 sheep and 120 head of cattle & horses
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 22, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner & place of use:
water is produced from a drilled well, thence pumped into a 2000 gallon storage tank, thence into 50 feet of flume type troughs located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 2,000 sheep, 100 head of cattle and 20 horses.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
