CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donald T. Hall has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump & distribution system for quasi-municipal & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 23, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 23 bears S. 80° 20' W., 500 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of works of diversion, manner & place of use:
water is developed by means of a drilled well and conveyed through a distribution system to 80 trailers, 5 casinos, 40 houses, and 335 apartments located within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 23, NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 26, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 27, SE 1/4, E 1/2 SW 1/4 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 22, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.,

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
