CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edmund G. Rich has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (mine shaft) through mine shaft, pump and pipelines for mining, milling & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 8N., R. 43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 23 bears N. 54° 15' W., a distance of 2,477.0 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Harold Johanson, Buck Johnston & Ed Rich

Post-office address North Hollywood, California

Amount of appropriation 0.2785 c.f.s. but not to exceed 43.92 mg per annum.

Period of use, from April 1st to December 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 24, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is developed from a mine shaft, thence pumped through 700 feet of 4 inch pipe to a small pond thence conveyed to the place of use located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used in a placer mining operation and recovery mill.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
