Water is diverted by means of an intake structure thence pumped to the Idlewild Treatment Plant. The water is then pumped into water mains serving the Reno-Sparks metropolitan area. The place of use is described as being within Sections 34, 35, and 36, T. 20N., R. 19E., Sections 31, 32 and 33, T. 20N., R. 20E., Sections 4 through 9, 17 through 20 and Section 30, T. 19N., R. 20E., Sections 1 through 4, 8 through 18, 20 through 27, T. 19N., R. 19E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Claim No. 325 Truckee River Final Decree, in Equity Docket A-3, in the District Court of the United States of America in and for the District of Nevada. (This change is from the Orr ditch to Idlewild Pump Station).

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
