CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Elaine B. Johnson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 8 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4) Sec. 21, T. 20N., R. 53E., M. D. B. & M. or at a point from which the East quarter-corner of said Sec. 21 bears S. 45° 52' 33" E. a distance of 1,833.41 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

\* Amount of appropriation 2.678 c.f.s. but not to exceed 688,888 acre feet annually
Period of use, from May 1st to October 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 6, 1962

\* This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit, with the understanding that the total annual duty of water from all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre irrigated.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
