CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James K. Stonier has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump & windmill for stockwatering & domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 31, T. 32N. R. 60E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Section 31 bears S. 65° 58' E., a distance of 2,895.0 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James K. Stonier & Dorothy A. Stonier

Post-office address Wells, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 9, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed at the well thence pumped by a windmill through 1 1/2" X 160' of pipeline into four 6 feet diameter stockwatering tanks 24" deep where it is used for watering 400 head of cattle. The place of use is located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
