CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Melvin Gokey has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 40N., R. 33E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 23, bears S. 57° 11' 40" W., a distance of 2502.0 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 3.0 c.f.s. but not to exceed 757.2 ac. ft. per season
Period of use, from February 15th to November 30th of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation June 10, 1959

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 18049 hence the priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 18049. This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
