CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dennis Heitman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 6, T. 43N., R. 37E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE 1/4 corner of said Section 6, bears S. 7° 11' E., a distance of 2,112.9 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 4,583 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1,228.0 ac. ft. annually.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 24, 1962

Table with 10 columns: Description of land to which the water is appurtenant, and rows listing acreage and section details (e.g., 37.5 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 6, T. 43N., R. 37E., M.D.B. & M.). Total: 307.0 acres total.

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 ac. ft. per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
