

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Robert J. Zander has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 31N., R. 59E., or at a point from which the West quarter-corner of said Section 28 bears N. 81° 33' W., a distance of 1,873.3 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Post-office address Elko, Nevada  
 Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s.  
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
 Date of priority of appropriation August 30, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is pumped from well by a 1 1/2 HP pump through 76 feet of 1 1/2" pipe to school building located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion and there used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
