CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Richard A. Bustoz (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Buck Spring No. 1 through pipeline to sprinkler system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10, T. 21N., R. 56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 15, T. 21N., R. 56E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 28° 09' 21" E., a distance of 9674.94 ft. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
