CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS James R. O'Banion has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15, T. 11N., R. 23E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 15 bears N. 7° 48' W. a distance of 5,273.80 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 2.72 c.f.s. but not to exceed 717.2 ac. ft. annually.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 ac. ft. per acre annually from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
