CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Helen V. Hawkins has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, distribution system and watering troughs for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, T. 19N., R. 20E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 18 bears N. 63° 14' 27" E., a distance of 1,596.08 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Helen V. Hawkins
Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.03 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 1,000 cattle, horses or sheep
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 14, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from a 6" X 48 foot deep well to a pressure tank, and thence distributed to watering troughs in a stockyard located in the N 1/2 NE 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 19N., R. 20E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to water 1,000 cattle, horses or sheep.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
