CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, and distribution system for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 28 bears N. 04° 55' W., a distance of 2,670.0 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Liberty Livestock Company
Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 4,000 head of cattle.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 7, 1966

Description of works of diversion manner and place of use: water is developed at the well thence pumped through 3/4 inch pipe 1600 feet in length connecting ten 2,000 gallon stockwatering tanks 15' X 2' located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 28, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B.&M., and used for stockwatering purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
