

THE STATE OF NEVADA  
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, distribution system for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 28 bears S. 77° 30' W., a distance of 2290.0 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Liberty Livestock Company  
Post-office address Eureka, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 037 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 4,000 head of cattle.  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation November 7, 1966

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed at the well thence pumped via 3/4 inch pipe line 127 feet in length to the cook house thence 400 feet to a 2,000 gallon stockwatering tank 15 feet in diameter X 2 feet deep. Water is also pumped from the well into a 175 gallon pressure tank thence conveyed 110 feet to trailer houses located within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M., and used for stockwatering and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
