CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert H. Shriver, Manager, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, T. 15N., R. 20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N. 1/4 corner of said Section 17 bears N. 4° 13' 10" E., a distance of 1,820.8 feet situated in Ormsby County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Carson Water Company
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 3.0 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 4, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner, and place of use: Water is pumped from a 535 ft. deep well to a settling tank, thence by centrifugal pump through mains and distribution system, where it is used for municipal purposes within all or portions of E 1/2 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 Section 12, and Section 13, T. 15N., R. 19E., M.D.B.&M.; all or portions of Sections 7, 8, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, and the N 1/2 Section 21, T. 15N., R. 20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
