

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joe Peacock - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rowe Creek Drainage Ditch & Natural Channel through ditch and reservoir for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T. 14N., R. 62E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 15, T. 14N., R. 62E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 17° 57' 54" E., a distance of 18,393.12 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:  
Name of appropriator Peacock Brothers - 1/3 interest Van C. & Margaret A. Gardner 1/2 int. Cannon & Elinor Gardner - 1/6 int. Neil L. & Virginia J. Gardner - 1/6 interest.  
Post-office address Lund, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0094 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 cattle  
Period of use, from March 1st through July 15th and August 15th to January 1st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation May 22, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is diverted by the Rowe Creek drainage ditch and natural channel from which 300 cattle water within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
