CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. P. Osgood - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for manufacturing and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 17, T. 19N., R. 20E., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 17 bears N. 64° 39' W., a distance of 4,801 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Belfast Bottling Company of Reno
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.133 c.f.s. but not to exceed 31,375 mg annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 3, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from an 8" dia. X 132 ft. deep well through a treatment plant and distribution system and used for the manufacture of soft drink beverages and domestic use in a plant located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
