CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS W. H. Settlemeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, earthen tank, and irrigation system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 4, T. 38N., R. 63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N. quarter corner of said Section 4 bears N. 31° 59' E., a distance of 2,633.41 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

\* Amount of appropriation 2.0 a.c.f.s. but not to exceed 368.0 ac. ft. per season.

Period of use, from April 1st to October 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 15, 1963

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

Table with 10 columns: Area, NE 1/4, NW 1/4, SE 1/4, SW 1/4, T, R, M.D.B.&M., and other details. Rows include 6.0 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 4, T. 38N., R. 63E., M.D.B.&M., and various fractional sections.

\*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit, with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 ac. ft. per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
