CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Max Magnusen has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hidden Canyon - Left Fork of Barber Canyon through earth dam and distribution system for Mining, Milling and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T. 33N., R. 36E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 13, bears S. 61° 58' E., a distance of 2,544.0 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Mary L. Clough and Max Magnusen
Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.081 c.f.s., but not to exceed 12.82 mg. annually
Period of use, from May 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 17, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by means of an earthen dam and 2" pipeline to one 400 gallon and one 1200 gallon storage tank and thence distributed through 1" diameter pipe for mining, milling and domestic use within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
