CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Pierre V. Paris has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Owens Springs through spring, reservoir and irrigation system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33, T. 26N., R. 62E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 33 bears S. 77° 30' E., a distance of 2,650.0 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
