CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS James J. O'Carroll, President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and distribution system for Quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 33N., R. 58E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 19 bears S. 53° 22' W., a distance of 2,466.57 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Lamaille Water Users, Inc.
Post-office address Lamaille, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 1.003 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.44 m.g. annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 3, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner, and place of use:
Water is pumped from a 12" X 230 ft. deep well with a 40 hp pump through 8" main to Town of Lamaille where it is used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes in the S 1/2 and the S 1/2 N 1/2 of Section 19, T. 33N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
