CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS W. H. Settelmeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump, storage tank and pipelines for milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10, T. 28N., R. 47E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 10 bears N. 32° 36' 40" W., a distance of 2,143.45 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.2785 c.f.s. but not to exceed 32.9 m.g. per April 1st to October 1st for milling/season
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year for domestic
Date of priority of appropriation August 3, 1960

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is produced from a drilled well, thence pumped into a 1,000 gallon storage tank and by pipeline to a trommel for milling gold, located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, N 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 9, T. 28N., R. 47E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
