CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Frank M. Groves, Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Moorman Springs Wash and Tributaries through Dam, diversion structure and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 10, T. 6N., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 9, T. 6N., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 74° 41' 11" W., a distance of 6,084.54 ft. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
