CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell-Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and watering troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 33, T. 44N., R. 27E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 33 bears N. 86° 46' E., a distance of 1,460.0 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Nevada Alder Creek Ranch
Post-office address Topeka, Kansas
Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 1, 1963

Description of works of diversion, place and manner of use:
water is pumped from a 10" diameter well by a submersible pump to a 32" half-round X 20 feet long watering trough located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion and there used to water 400 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
