CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer-Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and pressure system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 34N., R. 55E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 20 bears N. 46° 59' W., a distance of 2,208.85 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Carl A. and Irene Metzler
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.03286 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1440 gallons per day
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 30, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well, thence pumped into a pressure tank thence conveyed to a trailer located within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, T. 34N., R. 55E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
