CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Ivan S. Pearce has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and ditches for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 17, T. 44N., R. 34E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 17 bears N. 34° 38' W., a distance of 205.5 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle following

Period of use, from September 30th to May 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 7, 1965

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is produced from a drilled well thence pumped into existing irrigation ditches within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 17, T. 44N., R. 34E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used to water 500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
