CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. C. McFarlane - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, booster pump, pipeline and distribution system for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22, T. 35N., R. 50E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 22 bears N. 33° 10' 22" W. a distance of 230.66 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Carlin Gold Mining Company

Post-office address Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 1.0 c.f.s. but not to exceed 78.63 m.g. per annum

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 3, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use water is pumped from a 16" well, then through an 8" pipeline by a booster pump to a storage tank, from which it is distributed for mining, milling, and domestic use in an open-pit mine, and treatment plant located in Section 14, T. 35N., R. 50E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
